**RE: COMMUNITY CONSULTATION – PROPOSED RAISED PEDESTRIAN CROSSING –  
MYRTLE STREET AT PACIFIC HIGHWAY, CROWS NEST**

Council is proposing to install a raised pedestrian crossing on Myrtle Street at Pacific Highway, Crows Nest. The proposal includes extending the kerb on the northern side of Myrtle Street and providing zig-zag line-marking on approach to the crossing. These changes aim to improve safety for pedestrians crossing the street, reduce vehicle speeds, and provide greater visibility between drivers and pedestrians. A sketch of the proposal is attached.

The proposal comes in response to concerns about pedestrian safety at the intersection. This change also addresses the action for Item T.117 under the Council-adopted Local Area Traffic Management (LATM) Action Plan for Zone 2.

To comply with current technical directions and provide adequate visibility, approximately 2 parking bays on each side of Myrtle Street would need to be converted to “No Stopping”. A **“No Stopping”** restriction would prohibit vehicles from stopping at any point on the road or kerb in the direction of the arrow within the designated “No Stopping” area. In addition, the loading zone on the southern side of Myrtle Street would be moved further away from Pacific Highway.

The existing speed hump would be removed as part of the proposal.

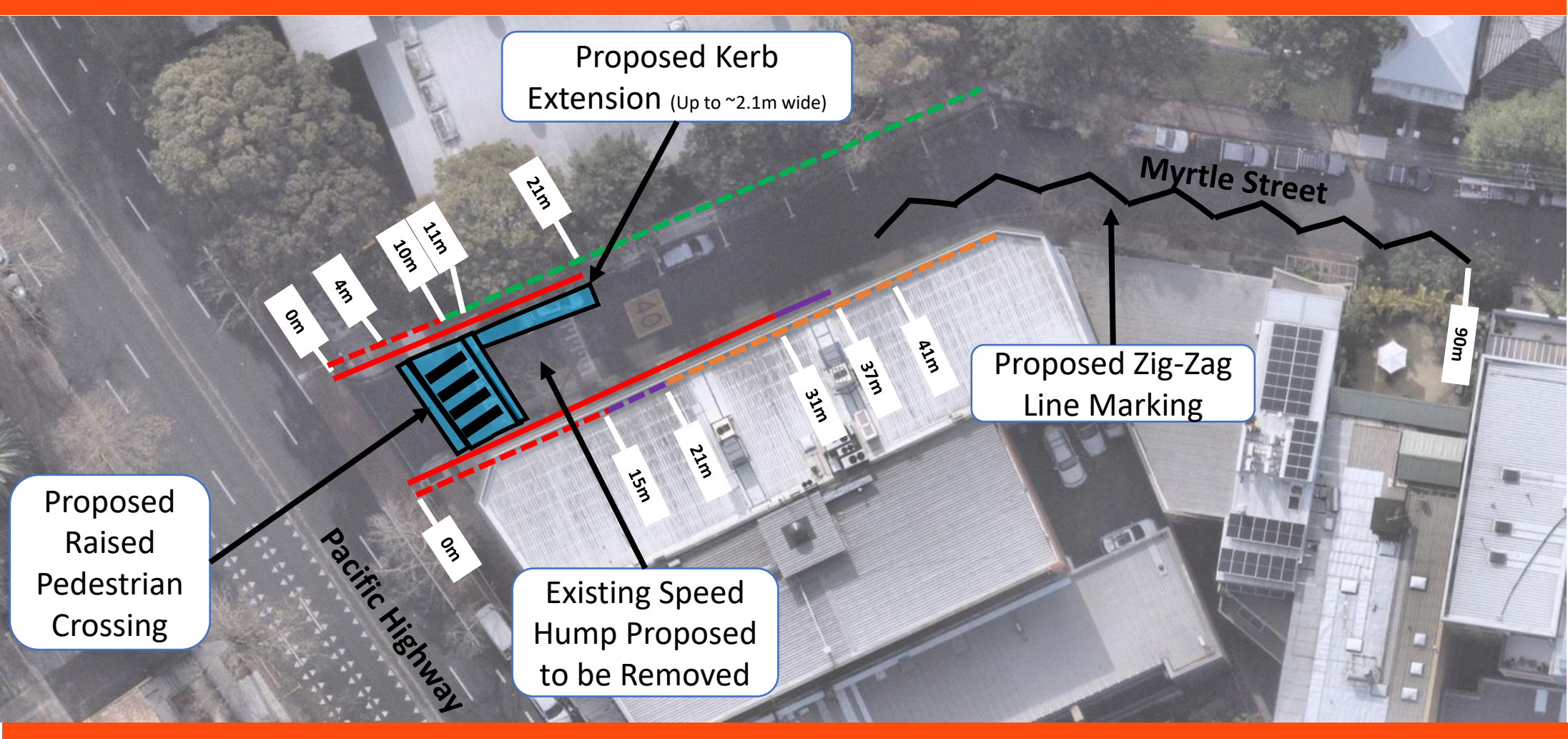
